Emergency Preparedness Plan

- Review CEM plans—determine if public health fully integrated
- Develop Public Health Emergency Plan to reflect infectious disease emergency by 6/30/2005
 - risk communication plan
 - Mutual Aid Agreements
 - identification of EDS
 - plan for EDS with staffing roster including identified roles, responsibilities and contact information
 - appropriate evacuation and/or sheltering plans
- Integrate EDS plan into CEMP
- HHAN
 - high speed internet to all LBOH
 - appropriate software and policies in place for LBOH computers
 - train someone from each town to use HHAN
 - identify an Information Officer
 - register as users appropriate people from local health departments
 - by 3/1/2005 be able to receive and confirm receipt of a test alert
 - 24/7 coverage by 6/1/2005
- Education and Training
 - develop strategic educational plan for coalition members – possible trainings include:
 - ICS/NIMS—Awareness Level
 - Risk Communication—Awareness Level
 - Disease Investigation—Awareness Level
 - Isolation and Quarantine—Awareness Level
 - Food Issues During Emergencies—information
 - Emergency Response Protocols and Equipment—Awareness Level
